Area History

The Mill Creek area is comprised of Clay, Franklin, and Liberty townships in the southwestern corner of Hendricks County. The rural nature of the area is an attraction for expanding businesses and people looking for a laid-back lifestyle and affordable living. Mill Creek is located along U.S. 40, and is steeped in history along the Old National Road.

The area's proximity to I-70 and easy access to Indianapolis International Airport have combined to make the area prime for development.



Education

The Mill Creek School Corporation, which includes Cascade High School, Cascade Junior High School and



two elementary schools, is home to 1,600 students and has consistently scored above state averages on standardized and college-application tests.



Commerce

Mill Creek's proximity to U.S. 40, I-70 and Ind. 39 make it a formidable player in economic development. Developers have discovered untapped areas of land at the I-70/Ind. 39 interchange and have started the process to attract industry. Currently, Stone Creek Business Park has available sites.



Future

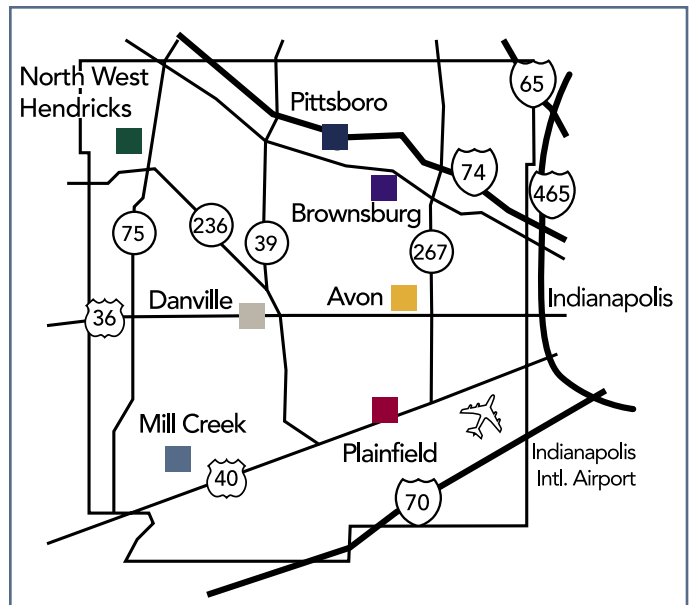
